- 2. The Director of Extension with the Chair of the Department is responsible for administering the funds.
- 3. Applications are to be submitted to the Chair of the Agricultural & Extension Education (AEE) Graduate Studies Committee.
- 4. The applicant must be admitted to the graduate program in Agricultural & Extension Education (AEE).
- 5. Applicants must use the application form available online.
- 6. Applicants may be asked to interview with a selection committee. Recipients may also be asked to meet with the donor, Lois Hungate, if it can be arranged.
- 7. The recipient will be notified of the award by the Director of Extension or Chair of the Department and will be informed of how and when the award funds may be accessed.
- 8. The amount and the number of awards to be made will be determined annually by the amount of funds available.
- 9. Awardees are expected to complete the graduate program which is supported by the award.
